We are excited to offer you All Access Licensure for test, micro-credential, and skills development courses, all for free! Once you log into the portal and create an account, please follow the guidelines below when registering for courses. On the website, you will click through different options. The below lists the different thematic areas that are in the store on the Albion Kaplan portal. Note, please only register for one course at a time and never double of the same course.

Areas of Interest

Professional Designations

Students in business should be considering these licensing exams if pursuing careers in financial or wealth management. Recommended for junior, senior, or graduate students.

Wealth Management

Students in business should be considering these licensing exams if pursuing careers in financial or wealth management. Recommended for junior, senior, or graduate students.

Securities Licensing

Students in business should be considering these licensing exams if pursuing careers in financial or wealth management. Recommended for junior, senior, or graduate students.

Professional Skills

Career Readiness, Resilient Leader, Foundations in Data Literacy, Exploratory Data Analysis, and Math and Python Fundamentals are great skills building courses for any student, anytime. Students from all majors and backgrounds can pursue these courses.

Confident New Hire is a great skill building course for students preparing to graduate. Student from all majors and backgrounds can pursue this course.

Only students planning to get certification as a project manager should take the Project Management Preparation Course. Students will not receive the certification following completion of the course; rather, they will be prepared to take the licensing exam for project management.

Graduate School Admissions

All students pursuing professional health, graduate school, graduate business degrees, and law school should be working with a pre-health, pre-law, or business advisor when considering preparation. Students requesting entrance exam prep have access to Kaplan prep products for

12 months. Therefore, students must ensure they are ready to test and apply to their respective programs within those 12 months.

Please follow the guidelines below:

DAT: students must be enrolled in or have completed Organic Chemistry II with BIO I/II and CHEM I/II.

GMAT: Recommended only for senior business students pursuing competitive b-school admissions. Determine if you need this exam based on schools you are applying to.

GRE: Recommended between junior and senior year only when applying to graduate programs that require the exam. (All PA and Veterinary programs require the GRE; most OT and PT programs require the GRE.)

LSAT: Junior or senior pre-law students only; recommended that all pre-law applicants completed before September of their application year.

MCAT: Recommended when students have completed BIO I/II, CHEM I/II, OCHEM I/II, PHYS I/II. Students should try to complete the MCAT by June of the year that they are applying.

OAT: Recommended when students have completed BIO I/II, CHEM I/II, OCHEM I/II, PHYS I/II, and through Calc I.

Engineering FE Exam

Students requesting prep resources for the FE exam have access to Kaplan prep products for 6 months. The earliest the FE exam can be taken is within a student's last term. Therefore, it is recommended a student request access no sooner than 6 months prior to graduation.

FE is highly recommended for mechanical and civil engineering students. It is recommended for all other engineering students as well.

Teacher Licensing

The PRAXIS Core is recommended early in your teacher education program to gain entry into higher level education courses. Students are required to take the exam after the sophomore year and prior to participating in student teaching. Please register for Kaplan PRAXIS test preparation at the conclusion of the sophomore year.
